Objects

- To establish a network for those involved with children's supervised contact.
- To disseminate information about and to act as a clearing house for information in relation to children's supervised contact.
- To develop, establish, practice and promote standards, policies and procedures that are culturally appropriate and sensitive to the needs of children and their families.
- To formulate the competency standards, skill and qualifications for the persons (operating) children's supervised contact services.
- To provide a forum where collective action for the promotion of children's supervised contact services can be facilitated.
- To encourage government and non-government funding for children's supervised contact services.
- To encourage research into issues related to children's supervised contact and into the development of service delivery.
- To print and publish any information that the society may think desirable for the promotion of its objects.
